GRAND KNIGHT REPORT

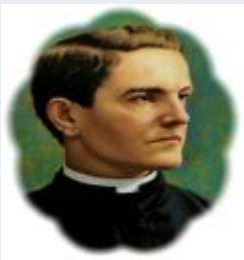
Greetings Brother Knights:
